

Applicant Declaration - Oak Post Plaque in Sapley Woods

- I would like to adopt a wooden plaque for the post in the Sapley Woods area at Huntingdon Crematorium.
- I understand that the plaque will be in place for 5 years, after which point, I can purchase a yearly lease extension at the Manager's discretion and only if the post is in satisfactory condition.
- I understand that if the lease expires, the plaque will be removed from the post without notice and the space will be made available to other families for adoption.
- I have read and agree to abide by the Council's regulations in force with regards to the management and control of Crematorium Memorials (abridged regulations below).

Sapley Woods Abridged Regulations

- 1. Unauthorised planting of bulbs, seeds, shrubs, trees or any kind of plant whatsoever is strictly prohibited within Sapley Woods.
- 2. No stake, slip, tube etc. of any material, memento or any other item of any sort may be attached to or placed on any part of Sapley Woods, including the trees.
- 3. Wreaths, plants, wind chimes, solar lights etc. may not be placed in the Woods; any that are left will be removed and disposed of.
- 4. Natural flowers may be placed loosely in the area where the cremated remains have been scattered. These will be cleared away after 7 days.
- 5. Artificial flowers are not permitted.
- 6. Small natural sprays or fresh flowers (not in a container or plastic) may be left in front of the Memorial Post and will be removed after a period of 7 days.
- 7. No vases, containers, jars, bottles, other receptacles or mementos are permitted within any area of the Woods.
- 8. It is not possible to reserve a particular site at the base of the post under a particular plaque for example. Only Council staff may relocate tributes against the post and this may be necessary from time to time.
- 9. Any unauthorised items in Sapley Woods will be removed and, if not claimed by the owner, will be disposed of after a period of one month.
